Theological	1	You've Been Saved to Lead!	We will discover that God created us to lead, and that through salvation God has empowered us to ultimately fulfill the original purpose of ruling over creation by looking after His interests over all the earth.
Technical	2	Dynamics of Core Ideology	We will define three common leadership concepts (values, mission, vision) and differentiate their shaping force in a ministry.
Biblical	3	NT Greek Words For Leadership Roles: Part 1: Elders	We will identify principles about the role of the elders in the church ministry. We will do so by identifying three key Greek words and by understanding the biblical requirements.
	4	NT Greek Words for Leadership Roles Part 2: Deacons	We will identify principles about the role of deacons by understanding the linguistic and cultural context, as well as the biblical requirements.
	5	The Role of Gender in Church Leadership	We will define the roles of gender in Church ministry by studying key passages and distinguishing between general leadership and headship.
Spiritual	6	The Spiritual Fiber of the Effective Leader	We will study the four essential spiritual elements of effective leadership.
	7	The Four Attitudes of the Effective Leader	We will study key attitudes that characterize level-five leadership.
Interpersonal	8	Team Dynamics Part 1: The Process of Decision Making	We will define the five elements of healthy decision making.
	9	Team Dynamics Part 2: The Improvement Cycle	We will describe the mechanisms that drive ministry effectiveness with special focus on the improvement cycle.
	10	Team Dynamics Part 3: Conflict Resolution	We will identify the biblical steps of godly confrontation.
