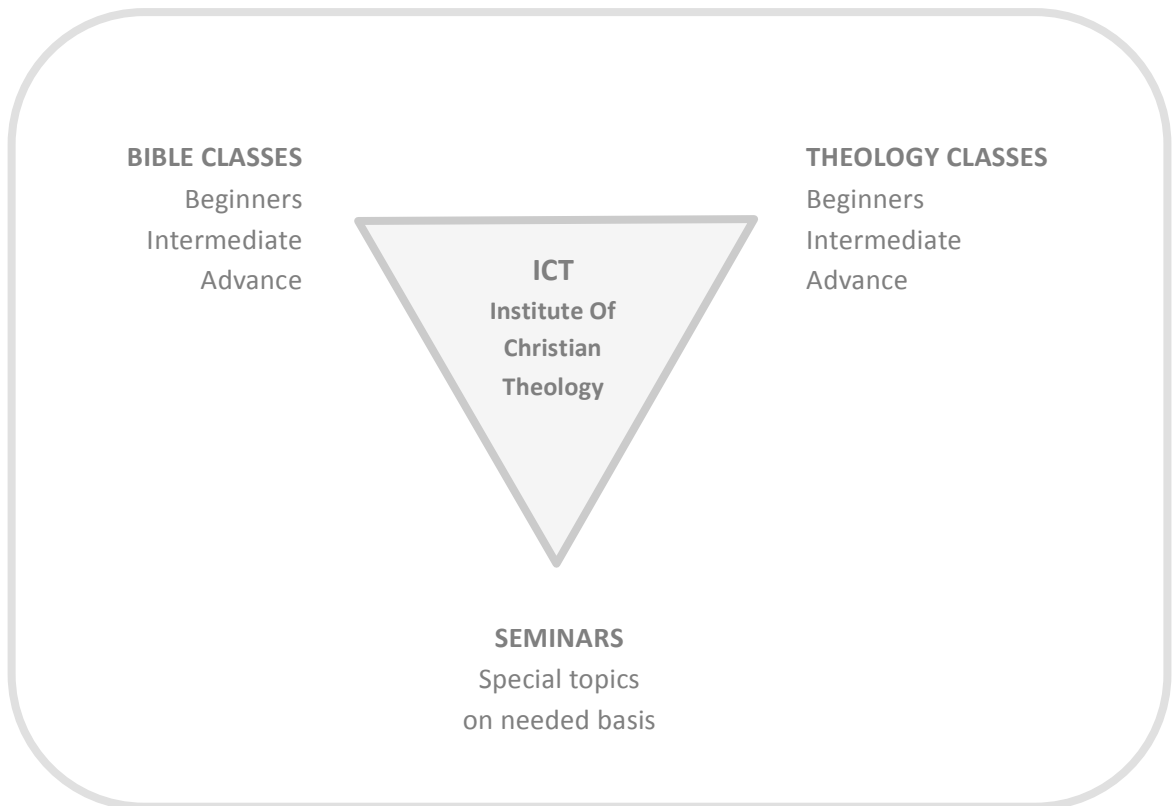


## **INTRODUCTION**

<b>BIBLE CLASSES</b>	
Level 1: Beginner	
OT Survey	An overview of the key characters and events of the Old Testament and their implications in the history of salvation.
NT Survey	An overview of the key characters and events of the New Testament and their implications in the history of salvation.
Level 2: Intermediate	
The Life of Christ	A chronological overview of the life of the Messiah with special attention to key places, events, and prophetic fulfillment of messianic prophecies.
Pentateuch	An overview of the key characters, events, and teachings of the first five books of the Bible.
Prophets	An overview of the key characters, events, and teachings of the prophetic books of the Old Testament.
Level 3: Advanced	
Acts	An expositional study of the book of Acts and its implications in our understanding of the doctrine of the church and the Holy Spirit.
Romans	An expositional study of the book of Romans and its implications in our understanding of the doctrine of salvation.
Daniel & Revelation	An overview of the key characters, events, and teachings of the book of Daniel and Revelation as it pertains to the doctrine of the end of times.

Level 1: Beginner	
How to Study the Bible	A study of key elements and techniques to read, interpret, and apply biblical truth.
Knowing God	A study on key biblical texts and their implications in our understanding of God's character, the doctrine of the Trinity, the deity of Christ, and the work of the Holy Spirit.
Level 2: Intermediate	
The Doctrine of Salvation	A study on key biblical texts and their implications in our understanding of the doctrine of salvation.
Church History	A chronological overview of the main events and characters that shaped the life of the church from Pentecost until today.
Level 3: Advanced	
Creation and Evolution	A study on key areas of the theory of evolution and the scientific evidence for intelligent design in the context of biblical interpretation.
The End of Times	A study on key biblical texts and their implications in our understanding of the doctrine of the end of times.
Essentials of the Christian Faith & World religions	A comparison between the essential doctrines of the Christian faith and the views of the major religions of the world.
